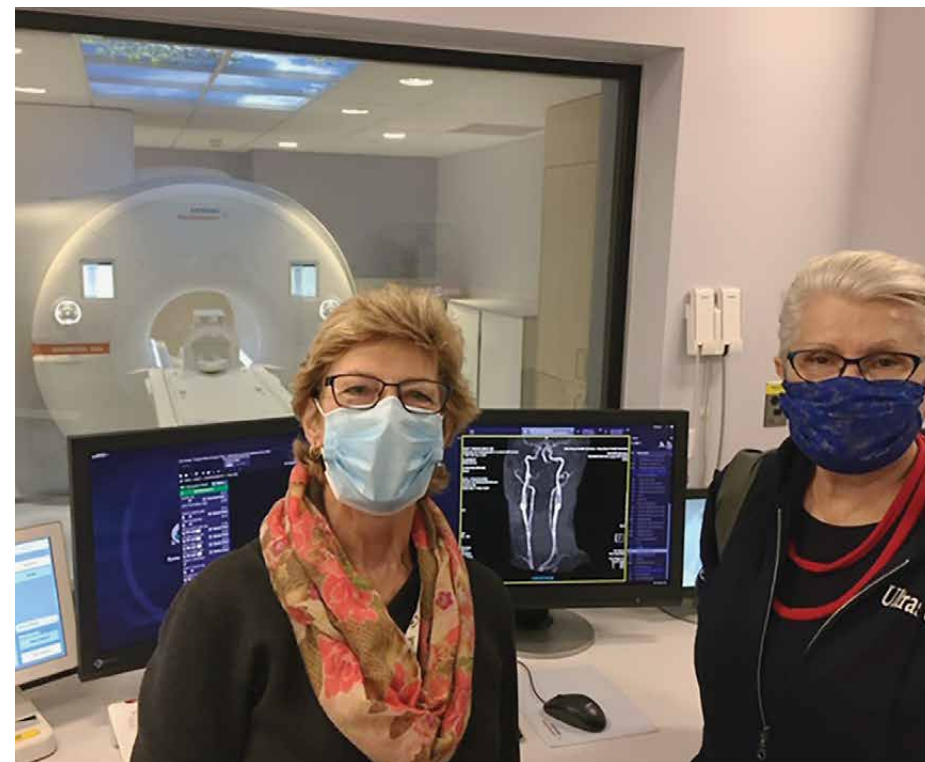

Grey Bruce Health Services is celebrating the arrival of its new MRI!

It is here! Thanks to donor support, on Tuesday August 4 the new Siemens Sola MRI arrived and was craned into place at the Owen Sound Regional Hospital. The replacement of our 17 year old MRI was a critical need for GBHS. And because of you the need was met.

The \$4.7 million required to purchase the MRI, and make required renovations inside of the MRI suite, was donated 100% by the community. The Five Foundations who worked collaboratively on all MRI fundraising initiatives include: the Owen Sound Regional Hospital Foundation, Bruce Peninsula Health Services Foundation, Centre Grey Health Services Foundation, Meaford Hospital Foundation and the Saugeen Memorial Hospital Foundation.

The new MRI offers many benefits including upgrades to perform new imaging sequences, some free breathing exams, meaning you will not have to “hold your breath”, a larger opening, crisper images helping the radiologists with diagnosis, the ability to image people with joint replacements.



There are also several patient safety upgrades. A camera on the MRI will allow technologists conducting the tests to keep a close watch on patients. The table can be removed from the MRI transferring patients from a bed or wheelchair easier and safer.

Staff are being trained on the new system, and patients are being

imaged today. By mid October 2020 all MRIs will be performed on the Sola MRI.

The new 1.5 Telsa MRI will be used to care for over 12,000 patients a year from across Grey and Bruce, and beyond to diagnose a range of medical conditions. Thank you for making this happen – you should be proud.

Case Carts are Up and Running!



In August, 51 of 75 new Operating Room Surgical Case Carts were delivered to our Medical Device Reprocessing Department (MDRD). The carts were unpackaged and sterilized and made ready for surgeries. A case cart is used to control sterility of medical devices during transportation. The new case carts are made of stainless steel so they are easier to clean.

A lot of team-work was required to get everything unloaded off the dock, unpacked, and reprocessed, and ready to use.

The shiny new case carts are up and running, with the old ones almost fully out the doors.

MDRD expects to receive the remaining 24 new carts in the near future. All of the new Surgical Case Carts, had a price tag of \$300,000. All paid for with donor support.



9 New Physicians

A new group of 9 physicians has moved into the area this year and has joined Grey Bruce Health Services. These physicians include specialists in Obstetrics & Gynecology, Pathology, Medical Imaging, Adult Psychiatry, Respiriology & Critical Care and Family Practice and they will be working throughout the Grey Bruce region.

In addition to the physicians, GBHS welcomes medical students. The corporation's medical education program supports an

average of 20 medical students and residents per month from Universities across Ontario. The program is an excellent way to offer medical students an opportunity to explore the Grey Bruce area, and many return after graduation to practice on a permanent basis or provide short-term coverage at our local hospitals.

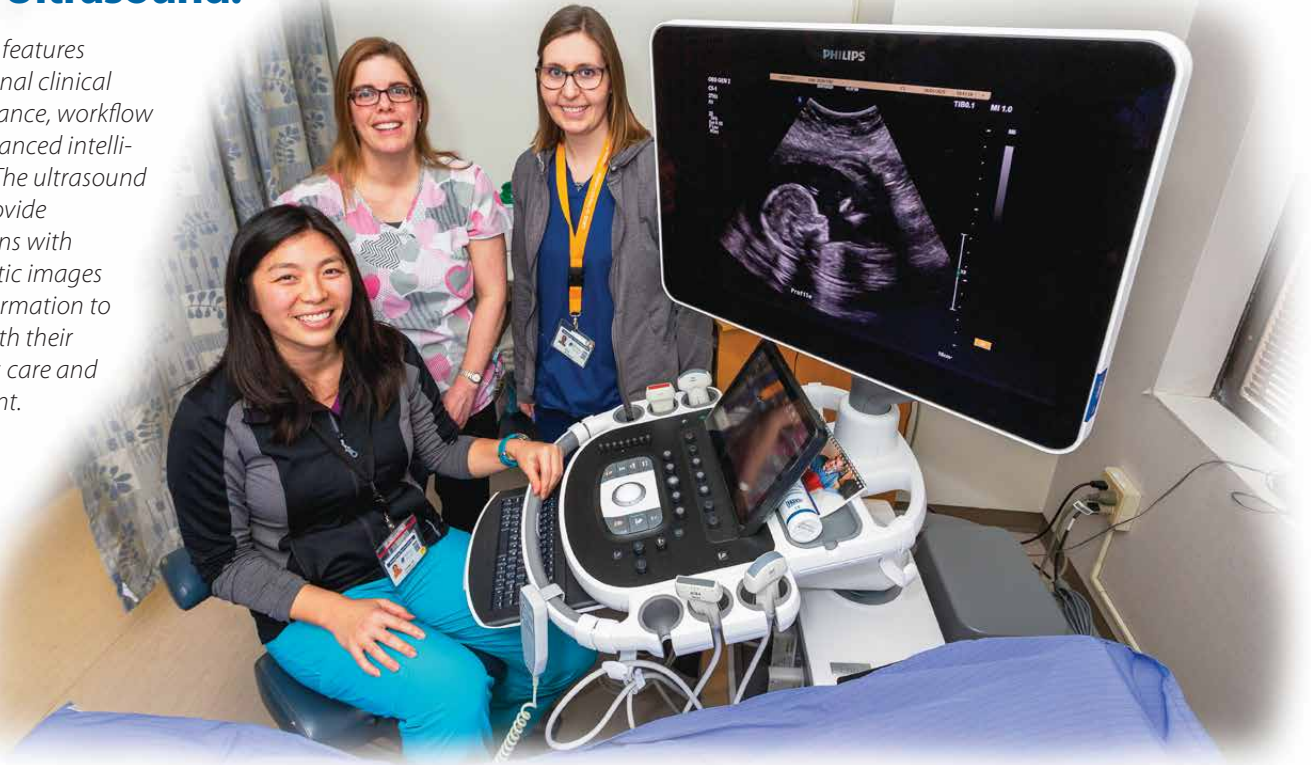
